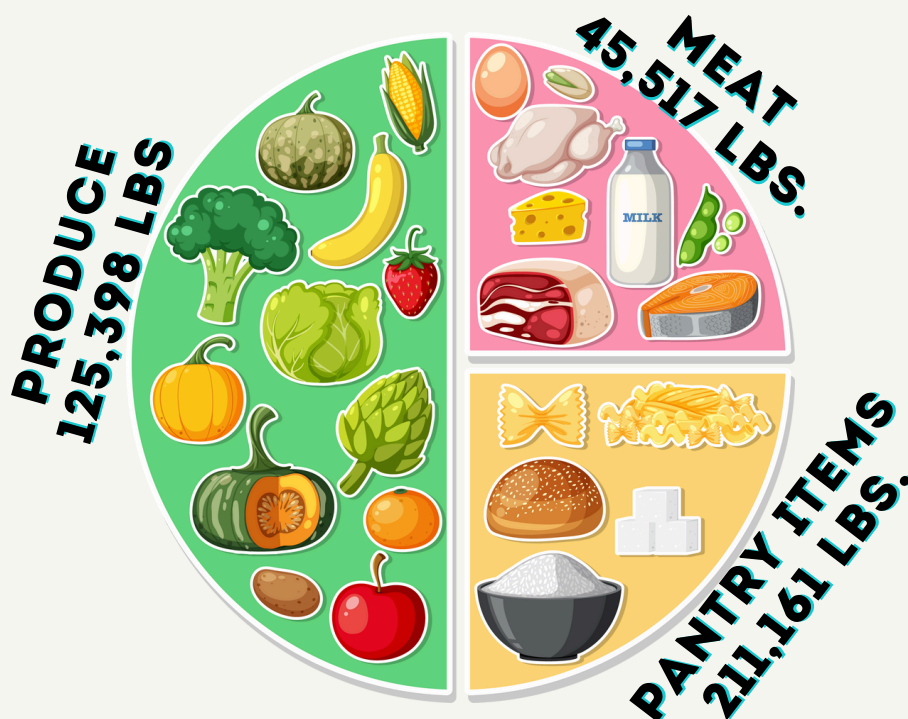
382,076 pounds of food distributed

EXPENSE CATEGORIES

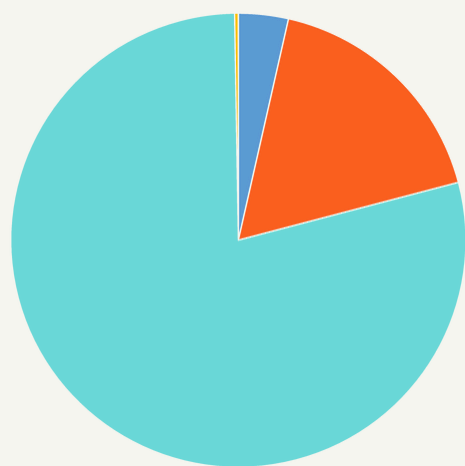
