In 1968, Monsignor Vincent Enright began a social service program to be directed by Sister Benita Repasky, SSJ. This became St. Martin Center; named after St. Martin de Porres, patron saint of social justice and the sick and poor.

In 1998, we added housing and financial education services. In 2018, we merged the housing and social service departments to form the Self-Sufficiency Department. This model more fully serves families.

In 2016, our Early Learning Center expanded to 18th and State, the site of a former bank, and added three classrooms, a multipurpose room, a staff training room, a parent conference room, and more.

While programming has changed over the years, our purpose remains the same.



- Keystone STARS 4-rated center (STARS is a state-wide program that rates centers on quality, curriculum, and more. STAR 4 is the highest rating and must be maintained yearly)
- Continuity of Care model:
 - o Child stays with a teacher until Pre-School age
 - The child moves to a new class at a time that mimics the transition to school
 - Teacher and family build a bond that allows for better child development and family care
- Free pre-kindergarten program through Pre-K Counts
